1. God's Healing



Exodus 15:25

And he cried to the Lord, and the Lord showed him a log, and he threw it into the water, and the water became sweet.



Exodus 15:25-26

There the Lord made for them a statute and a rule, and there he tested them, ²⁶ saying, "If you will diligently listen to the voice of the Lord your God, and do that which is right in his eyes, and give ear to his commandments and keep all his statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you that I put on the Egyptians, for I am the Lord, your healer."

So Moses cried to the Lord, "What shall I do with this people? They are almost ready to stone me."










Summary Lessons from Exodus 17:

- 1. God is your healer day by day and not just when you are sick
- 2. Unless you see the big picture of God's longsuffering nature in your life, you will not be patient or relaxed in your circumstances
- 3. God's grace flows from hard and tough places





Therefore the people <u>quarreled</u> with Moses and said, "Give us water to drink."

And Moses said to them, "Why do you <u>quarrel</u> with me? Why do you test the Lord?"



And he called the name of the place Massah and Meribah because of the <u>quarreling</u> of the people of Israel, and because they tested the Lord by saying, "Is the Lord among us or not?"
