## Dear Agapian,

Welcome to Agape's Bible-Reading Plan for 2025! Let me introduce you to this plan – by telling you what it is NOT:

This is not a “read the Bible in a year” kind of plan.

This is not a plan for you to “tick off” the daily assigned readings.

This reading plan has been carefully curated to encourage you to spend quality time daily, in God's word. Here are 3 possible ways you could use this reading plan:

**#1. Old Testament (OT) Track:** From Monday to Saturday, you will be assigned a chapter from the OT. On Sundays, it will just be a psalm. If you follow along this track, you will not finish the entire OT in a year. However, you will have covered the major storyline of the OT.

**#2. New Testament (NT) Track:** Each weekday, you will read a chapter from the NT. On Saturdays, you will read a chapter from the Old Testament's Wisdom literature. On Sundays, it will just be a psalm. If you follow along this track, you will finish the entire NT in a year.

**#3. Both OT and NT Tracks:** Read all the assigned readings. You will cover two chapters a day – except on Sunday (which is just a psalm). You will cover the major OT storyline and the entire NT in a year.

Bible-reading is not a sprint – it's a marathon. Thus the old African proverb has a lot of relevance here: *“If you want to go fast, go alone. If you want to go far, go together.”* I encourage you not to dive into this Bible-reading plan on your own. Find a community (e.g. cell group) to read the Bible with daily.

My prayer is that as we read the Bible daily, we would encounter our Saviour day by day, and He would challenge and sharpen us – until we truly become that “catalyst in the city for the gospel”.

One final encouragement: Don't make your Bible-reading about “finishing the plan”. Make it about encountering Jesus. Don't miss the daily opportunities to draw near to God, just because you want to tick off your chapter(s) for the day!

Remember Jesus' words from John 5:39 – “You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; **and it is they that bear witness about me**”.

Let's encounter Jesus together through His word this new year.

# HOW TO read the Bible

Here is a simple method to use for your daily Bible reading.  
Ask these 4 general questions of the passage you are reading.<sup>1</sup>



## 1: God

### Q: What does this passage say about God?

The main subject of the Bible is God. Each passage will point us to God either directly or indirectly. Ask yourself if the passage points to aspects of God's character (e.g., holiness, power, love, mercy, glory) or to His actions (e.g., saving His people, judging His enemies, giving His Word, sending His Spirit).

## 2: Fallen Condition Focus (Sin)

### Q: What does this passage say about sin or the effects of sin (our fallen condition)?

If the Bible is primarily about God, it is secondarily about us. Ever since the fall (Gen 3) the entire universe has been broken and we all suffer the consequences of the fall daily. It is important to differentiate between sin and the fallen condition. The Fallen Condition Focus (FCF) is referring to a much larger category than just sin. It definitely includes sin, but it also includes the effects of sin and the fall. For example: i) suffering ii) sickness iii) poverty iv) natural disasters are not sins but they are a result of sin or the brokenness of this fallen world. Every text has an FCF. Every text addresses a problem that we face as humans in this fallen world. We need to rightly identify and address the FCF that is in the passage. Another way to identify the FCF is to identify the command that God gives. If the command is "do not murder", the sin is murder. Sometimes we might need to identify the opposite of a command. If the command is to "rejoice in the Lord always", the opposite is to be always sad and depressed.



## 3: Christ Connection (Jesus)

### Q: How does this passage point us to Christ?

Read Luke 24:25-27, 44-47 & 1 Peter 1:10-11. From these passages, we see that Jesus showed his disciples how the whole Old Testament pointed to himself. Peter tells us that even the Old Testament prophets studied the Scriptures to find out how they would point forward to the coming Messiah. In the same way, no matter what passage we are studying, we need to ask how this text points us to the life, death, resurrection and return of Christ. Christ is the fulfilment of every theme that emerges from every text. Christ is the solution to the problem that is raised by every text.



## 4: Application

### Q: What is God saying to me through this passage by His Spirit?

It is important to answer the first three questions before asking the application question. We must first understand what God said to His original audience before asking what God is saying to you today. For application, apply God's word to your own heart. Search your own heart to see if there is anything you need to repent of, if God is guiding you to do something for Him, or if God is teaching you to cherish His promises to you.
