WELCOME**HERE WE ARE.**

It's been two years since our last camp. Over these two years, God has been restoring a sense of identity to Agape, as well as a sense of mission. What has God called us to? *To be the catalyst in the city for the gospel to awaken and enliven believers and seekers.*

As a church, we are still wrestling with the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic. We've heard a lot about the bodily effects of "long-covid". But there's another, spiritual "long-covid" that impacts the soul – and we're continuing to deal with the consequences:

The personalisation of faith.

The prioritisation of our own welfare.

The digitalisation of discipleship.

The eradication of devotional space.

The informatisation of the glory of God.

Every church camp we have, is our fight against – and our *reversal* of – these consequences. Church camp is where faith becomes communal again. Where "one another" becomes the priority. Where discipleship returns to being relational. Where devotional space abounds. And where the glory of God is now *experienced* and *savoured* as a gospel community in covenant with God.

Did you come prepared? I hope you did.

This year's church camp theme is on being "CALLED". Who is calling us? What does it mean to be called? What are we being called to? What does it matter if we answer the call or not? These are questions I hope to answer through the first 7 verses of the book of Romans.

We have a whole line-up of sessions and workshops, *designed* to bring us deeper in the gospel. But any transformation, any lasting life-change, any repentance, any revelation of truth – comes from God. *We so need Him!*

So would you answer His call with all seriousness at this camp? Guard this space, *jealously*. Put aside your work. Give fun and fellowship their rightful place – *beneath* the priority of meeting God. And let's answer God's call – not only personally, but as a family of faith.

I'm trusting God that whatever happens in this camp, will shape our church for the renewal of our city, for the planting of new churches, for an explosion of faith and devotion among Agapians – for years to come.

Let's expect, demand, and hunger for Big things from our Big God.



What should I do if there are issues with my room?

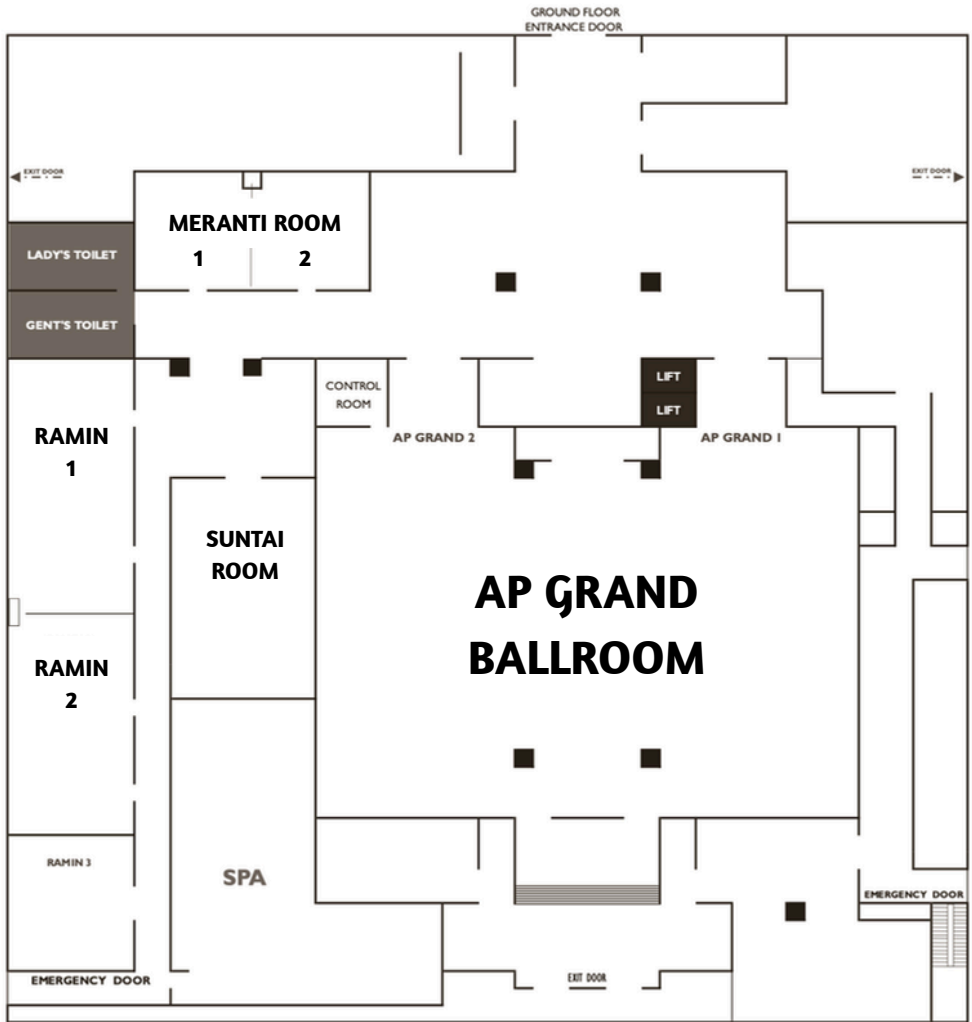
For room-related concerns (e.g. air-con, key card, amenities), please contact the hotel front desk directly.
